

## 360 Lesson Observation

You will now have the opportunity to use the Instructional Practice Guide to practice observing a lesson.

To use the Instructional Practice Guide, you will need to observe a lesson (video or live). In addition to the observation, it may be helpful to look at artifacts that support the lesson such as: the lesson plan, student work, and/or a transcript of the lesson.

## **Directions:**

- 1. Read the lesson plan to get an idea of what the lesson is about.
- 2. As you observe the lesson take notes in the Instructional Practice Guide. Gather evidence on both teacher actions and student behaviors.
- 3. Use the notes you've taken to reflect on each indicator. Provide evidence for each rating in the notes section of the Instructional Practice Guide.
  - If there are any indicators that you are not able to reflect on, note what questions you would ask to gather the evidence needed to reflect on each indicator.
- 4. Share your reflections and evidence for each indicator with a small group. Try to come to consensus on the ratings.
