PARCC Assessment Item Illustrating 7.EE.B.3

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A store pays two fees when a customer uses a credit card to make a purchase. These fees include

- a flat fee of \$0.15 and
- a processing fee equal to 1.75% of the dollar amount of the purchase.

There is no sales tax on the purchase.

Part A

What is the amount, in dollars and cents, the store pays in fees for a \$60.00 purchase by a customer using a credit card?

Part B

The store gives a discount to customers who use cash instead of a credit card for a

purchase. The discount is equal to $\frac{5}{5}$ of the 1.75% processing fee the store would be charged if a credit card was used.

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A customer will make a \$150 purchase using cash. What will be the discount, in dollars and cents, for using cash instead of a credit card on this purchase?

Elaboration on Alignment

This grade 7 standard requires students to be able to solve multi-step problems involving rational numbers presented in a variety of forms. Typical of modeling problems, this item has many different quantities to attend to (prices, fees, surcharges, etc.) The real-world context allows students to continually evaluate the reasonableness of their results. This item reflects previous learning from many major work standards in grades 4 -6, including computations involving fractions, decimals, and percentages. (Note that students would have access to a calculator for this item.)

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
