<p>2. <b>Coherence: Think</b> across grades, and <b>link</b> to major topics within grades</p>		
<p>3. <b>Rigor:</b> In major topics pursue <b>conceptual understanding</b>, procedural skill and <b>fluency</b>, and <b>application</b> with equal intensity</p>
