 - Determine which model is most appropriate
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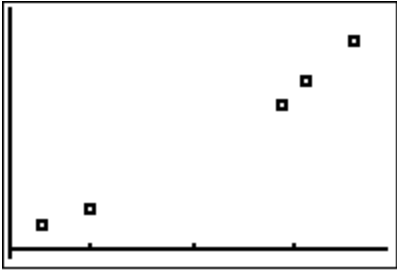
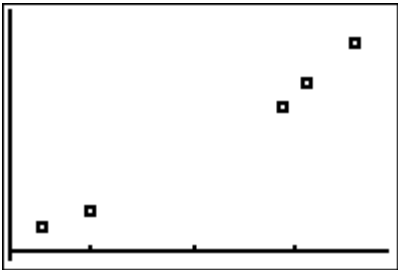
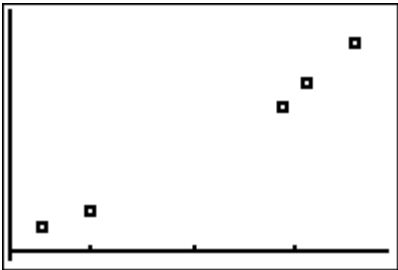
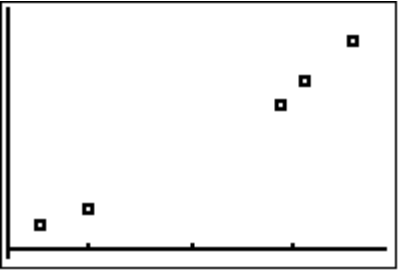
As you work through these problems, make conjectures about

How can each of these assist you in determining the most appropriate model?

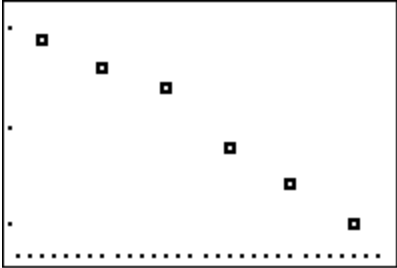
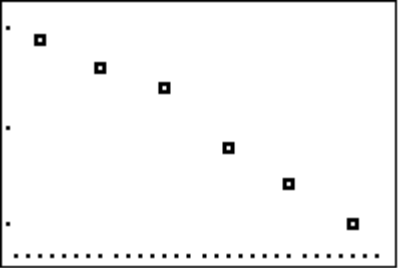
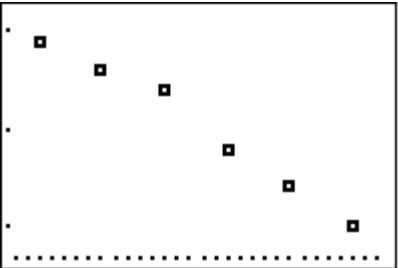
